We are beginning to use class dojo. Class Dojo is an easy way to track your child's behavior. Incentive points are given for exhibiting positive behaviors like staying on task, helping others, and following directions the first time. Points may be deducted as well for being disrespectful, getting off task, or not following directions the first time. When parents sign up on class dojo, you can track your child's behavior. Parents: students must accumulate 10 points a day, or 50 points a week to be able to participate in a fun Friday activity. Encourage your student to collect as many positive points as they can!!
